

RESOLUTION NO 14- _____

A RESOLUTION URGING OHIO VOTERS TO SUPPORT STATE
ISSUE 1, RENEWAL OF THE STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
PROGRAM ON THE MAY 6, 2014 BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Ohio local communities are in continuing need of support for vital road, bridge, sewer, water and other infrastructure projects, and

WHEREAS, Ohio has in place a state program of support for local communities which not only helps to fund infrastructure projects, but also creates large numbers of construction and allied jobs, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio State Capital Improvements Program has successfully provided support for more than 11,500 such projects and resulting job creation since its inception in 1987, and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 on the May 6, 2014 statewide ballot provides Ohio voters with the opportunity to renew the program by authorizing issuance of \$1.875 billion in capital improvement bonds, and

WHEREAS, no new taxes are required to fund repayment of the bonds;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1. This Council hereby declares its support for State Issue 1, and urges Ohio voters to cast their votes in support of continuing the infrastructure improvement and job creation Issue 1 will foster.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
